This 6 day camp focuses on issues relevant to young people. The SFL Summer Camp addresses challenges facing youth including social justice and equality issues. It combines learning with cooperative recreation activities and lots of guaranteed fun!

### **WHAT DOES IT COST?**

Registration is \$350 per camper (\$425 for non affiliates). Some affiliated unions subsidize this cost- check with your union local.

Full registration is payable upon confirmation of camp attendance.

**Arrangement for payment by the union is the responsibility of the camper's parent(s).**

The SFL covers the cost of wages for Recreation Staff and Youth Activity Coordinators and other expenses relating to course material and activities.

Arrangements can be made to ensure no one is excluded because of cost.

### **WHAT WE GUARANTEE:**

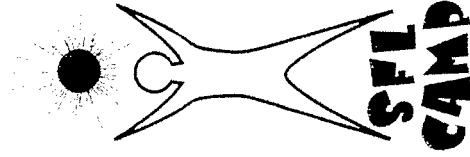
A fun and safe environment where campers experience active learning based on cooperation, equality and social justice.
